ACTION ITEMS

Proposed changes to the ICAPO Operating Policies to be considered.

ARTICLE V: EXTENSION

Section 2. Requirements For Establishing a Chapter: A charter shall be granted only on the approval of an appropriate nationally elected governing body of the sponsoring organization. A charter shall be granted only at a college or university which is accredited by a recognized accrediting association. Charters are to be recognized and held by the host college or university. The sponsoring organization shall determine which accrediting associations will be recognized. The International Council shall be informed as to the name of the accrediting association(s).

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS

Section 7. Time & Place: The International Council shall meet at least once every two (2) years. The time and place for the next meeting shall be determined as an agenda item. If the International Council is unable to physically conduct business at scheduled meetings due to the lack of a quorum, the Chair may call and preside over a teleconference or video conference. A minimum of 2 months notice should be given to the Council officers and member organizations.

Our delegation and our counterparts in the Philippines have not agreed on further changes to the ICAPO Operating Policies at this time concerning

- minimum chapters required to establish an new national organization
- proportional voting by member organizations
